The Korscient Personal Digital Index (PDI) is a new way to search for ***your information***. How many times have you asked yourself:

"I visited a site that had some interesting stuff about remembering all my digital experiences but I can't remember where I saw it."

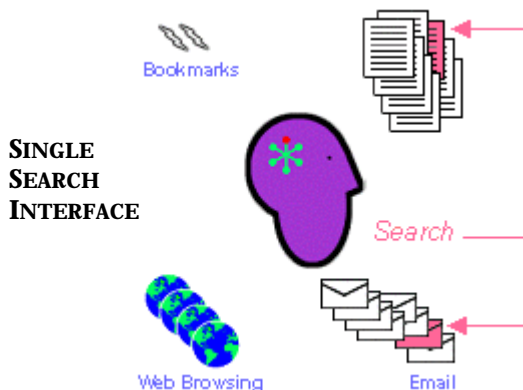
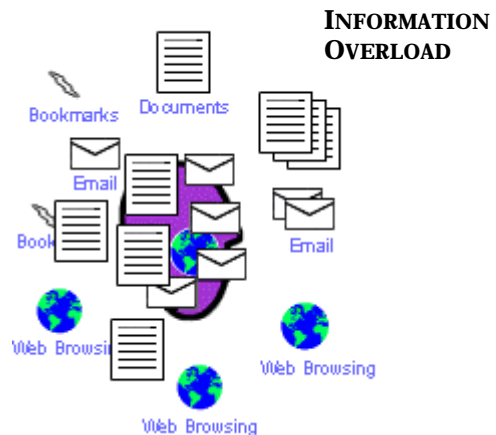
The PDI is designed to capture all your digital experiences on your own machine and to give you an easy way of finding them again.

Major search engines give you a way of finding information on the web – an enormous task requiring massive servers capable of storing the millions of pages available.

We provide a different facility. We locate your own personal information.

Everybody receives a huge amount of information: from email, documents (Word, Excel, PowerPoint, pdfs etc) and from surfing the web.

The amount of information received can lead to the recipient becoming swamped.



The Personal Digital Index organizes your information into suitable categories.

This would include both work related and private information if you wish.

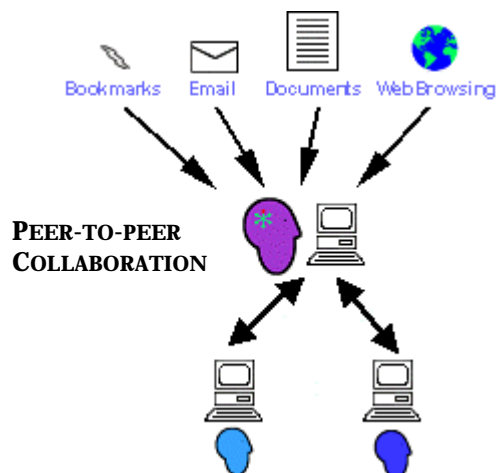
We then provide a single search interface that will find the information you want based on keywords or categories. It will find a document whether it's on your machine, a file server or an attachment to an email. Most usefully, it will also find web pages you've browsed that match your search criteria.

We allow you to share your PDI. Why?

- Perhaps you work as part of a corporate research team and want an easy way of sharing information with your colleagues.
- Perhaps you share an interest or hobby with a group of friends.

You can search their Personal Digital Indexes (and vice versa). The chances are that if they've stored the information in their PDI then it's likely to be more relevant than some of the 'hits' you get back from major web search engines.

Of course, the PDI contains security measures so that others will only have access to the information you want them to have.
